On the thirty first day of Oct-  
tober, one thousand eight hundred  
and fifty nine, personally appeared  
before me a justice of the peace in and  
for the said County and state, Elizabeth  
Mayer, aged one hundred years as near as she  
can recollect, a resident of Antis Township,  
Blair County Pennsylvania, who, being  
duly sworn according to law, declares that  
she is the widow of Jacob Mayer, Second,  
who was a private in the war against  
Great Britain, known as the Revolution-  
ary war. She does not recollect the com-  
pany nor <sup>the</sup> Regiment, nor the names of  
the commanding officers of the same,  
but he enlisted at Reading, and served  
to the end of the war, the time of service  
she thinks was about seven years.

She further states that he was a pen-  
sioner before he died, and that the facts  
upon which that pension was granted  
she presumes were before the department.

She further states that she was  
married to the said Jacob Mayer, in  
the town of Reading, by the Rev Mr  
Baas, a minister of the Gospel, as near  
as she can now recollect, about seventy  
six years ago, that her husband died  
in what is now Blair County Pennsylvania
